## PRE-SCHOOL

### Early Education Funding

All children are entitled to 15 hours of free early education from **the term after their third birthday**.

- Third birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> September and 31<sup>st</sup> December would be eligible for funding the following January
- Third birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 31<sup>st</sup> March would be eligible for funding the following April
- Third birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 31<sup>st</sup> August would be eligible for funding the following September

Some children are entitled to funding from the term after they are **two years old**, this is usually due to low income. If you have an older child eligible for Free School Meals your two year old may well be eligible for 15 hours of free early education. If you have any questions about the two year old funding, please ask in your local Children's Centre or Buckinghamshire County Council.

### Age 3-4

**Finches Class:** Children who turn 4 between 1<sup>st</sup> September and end of February

**Goldcrests Class:** Children who turn 4 between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 31<sup>st</sup> August

The above children start in their classes in September and stay in their group until they move in to Reception Class and full time school. The sessions are 8.45-11.45am Monday to Friday.

### Age 2-3

**Firecrests Class:** Children who turn 3 from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> August

12.45 to 3.45pm Monday to Friday. Funded children attend for all 15 hours. Non-funded children's parents may opt to pay for up to 5 sessions.

September intake:

- Funded 2 year olds
- Paid spaces for children turning 3 between 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> December

January intake:

- Funded 2 year olds
- Funded 3 year olds with birthdays 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> December
- Paid spaces for children turning 3 between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 31<sup>st</sup> March

April intake:

- Funded 2 year olds,
- Funded 3 year olds with birthdays 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> March
- Paid spaces for children turning 3 between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 31<sup>st</sup> August

At Newtown Pre-School we prioritise the children that live within our school catchment area. If we have places remaining after this, then we use the same admission criteria as the school. This can be viewed on our school website.

### Non-funded children

- The sessions cost £18 for a 3 hour session.

### Allocation dates

You can register your child at any time after their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday. Allocations will be done based on the registrations received by the following dates each year. Offer letters will be sent out a week to 10 days after the closing date.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in May for children starting the following September
- 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in October for children starting the following January
- 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in February for children starting the following April

**There is no guarantee that non-catchment children who are in our Pre-School will automatically move in to our School full time: catchment children will always take priority even if they have not attended our Pre-School. All children need to apply for a full time school place at Newtown whether they are in the Pre-School or not.**
