PRE-SCHOOL

Early Education Funding

All children are entitled to 15 hours of early education from **the term after their third birthday**.

- Third birthday between 1st September and 31st December would be eligible for funding the following January
- Third birthday between 1st January and 31st March would be eligible for funding the following April
- Third birthday between 1st April and 31st August would be eligible for funding the following September

Some children of working parents are eligible for **30 hours** of funding from the term after their third birthday, **we only offer the 30 hours for children in the age range for Goldcrests Class**.

Some children are entitled to funding from the term after they are two, this is usually due to home circumstances, if you have an older child eligible for Free School Meals your two year old may well be eligible for 15 hours of free early education.

Age 3-4 Goldcrests

Goldcrests Class: children who turn 4 between the 1st September and the 31st August. These children start in their classes in September and stay in their group until they move to Reception (full time school). The sessions are Monday – Friday 08:45 – 11.45. Children do start later in the year if we have a space. If your child is eligible for 30 hours they must do every morning but we are negotiable on the number of afternoons. The majority of 30 hour children do 8.45am to 2.45pm every day and there is an option to stay until 3.15pm for an additional fee.

Age 2-3 Firecrests

Firecrests Class: children who turn 3 between the 1st September and the 31st August. The sessions are Monday-Friday 12.15 – 15:15. Funded children attend for all 15 hours. Non-funded children's parents may opt to pay for up to 5 sessions.

September intake:

- Funded 2 year olds
- Paid spaces for children turning 3 between 1st September to 31st December

January intake:

- Funded 2 year olds
- Funded 3 year olds with birthdays 1st September to 31st December
- Paid spaces for children turning 3 between 1st January and 31st March

April intake:

- Funded 2 year olds
- Funded 3 year olds with birthdays 1st September to 31st March
- Paid spaces for children turning 3 between 1st April and 31st August.

At Newtown Pre-School we prioritise children that live within our school catchment area. We do not accept 2 year old children who live outside our catchment area.

Non-funded children

- The sessions cost £18 for a 3 hour session. This is payable for all sessions your child is registered to attend, not just the sessions they actually attend.

Additional ½ hour for 30-hour children (2.45 – 3.15pm)

- This costs £3 per session and is payable for all the sessions your child is registered to attend, not just the sessions they actually attend.

There is no guarantee that non-catchment children who are in Pre-School will automatically move into our school; catchment children will always take priority even if they have not attended Newtown Pre-School. All children need to apply for a school place through Buckinghamshire Council.
