As a parent / carer I will do my best to:

- Attend parent's evenings and parent information evenings to keep fully informed about my child's progress and activities.
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems which might affect my child's educational or emotional well-being.

- Ensure that my child comes to school regularly and provide an explanation for any absence before 8.30am on the same day, so that I can work with staff to support my child through any absences.
- Hear my child read **at least** three times a week at home and help them with their Funky Phonics homework.
- Ensure my child has everything they need for school including the correct named school uniform, book bag and PE Kit.
- Support the school in its behaviour approach including attending celebrations like Superstars Assembly where possible.
- Respect the rights of my child at all times in line with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.
